The 200 Club is a fun way to give LCR extra support.

The club runs on an annual basis from April to March the following year and is open to anyone who applies. To take part in the club you are asked to pay a minimum of £10. For each £10 you pay you are allocated a number which is entered into a cash prize draw each month until the end of the club year. Memberships received after April will be entered into the remaining draws until next March.

The draw is held at the end of each month and winners are notified shortly afterwards. No claim is necessary. Winning names and numbers will be published in the LCR newsletter.

Half of the money raised is used as LCR funds and the remainder forms the prize fund. We hope to award between 20 and 30 prizes throughout the year ranging from **£50 to £150**. With your support the 200 Club generates a substantial donation towards our rescue work.
